



## ADMISSION PROCESS

- New admissions commence in the first week of December every year.
- In order to seek admission the registration form can be obtained from the school office on payment of the prescribed fee.
- Minimum age in years for Admission is Nursery (3+), LKG (4+), UKG (5+) and Class-1 (6+) as on 01 April 2026.
- Registration does not, in any way, guarantee admission. The school reserves the right to accept or reject any application for admission without assigning any reason.
- The registration form must be complete in every respect and returned to the school within the time mentioned by the school office/authority. (UDISE, PEN No.)

### Documents required at the time of Admission :

- A passport size photograph of the child, father, mother and guardian is required.
- Official copy of an eligibility certificate for example OBC, SC, ST, if applicable.
- Official Birth Certificate of the applicant (Attested by parents) and photo copy of Aadhar Card of the child and parents/guardians is essential for registration of admission. Affidavits are not accepted as valid certificates.
- The school gives admission to the disadvantaged and economically backward children only under the RTE Act in I (first) Class according to the norms set by the Rajasthan Government.
- For admission in class UKG onwards, Transfer Certificate from a recognized school is essential for admission along with marksheet of the previous session examination conducted by that school/board.
- Transfer case students admitted late during the term are allowed to join only after an undertaking from parents regarding making up for the loss of time & studies.
- Students joining in Class XI, if appearing from any board other than CBSE, must submit Migration Certificate.
- Admission in class IX & XI will be as per CBSE Guidelines.

## STUDENT PROMOTION POLICY

### CLASS NURSERY TO II

There will be no formal exam. However, the academic session is divided into three evaluations. The child will be evaluated as per Continuous Comprehensive Evaluation guidelines laid down by DAVCAE, New Delhi.

### CLASS III TO VII

The academic session will be divided into two terms having 50% syllabus in first and remaining 50% and a part of first term in second term. There will be two Pen Paper Tests having 70% weightage and Internal Assessment having 30% weightage in each term. Different competencies will be assessed under the assessments to shape up the students of 21st century.

### CLASS VIII

The child will be evaluated as per the guidelines laid down by DAVCAE, New Delhi with regular Periodic Tests, Terminal Examinations & Internal Assessment. The DAVCAE will conduct Term End Examination.

### SECONDARY SECTION (IX-X)

The academic session is divided into 3 Periodic Tests & 2 Term examinations (Term 1 & Term 2 \*). The Student has to secure minimum 33% marks overall in theory exam of each subject for promotion to the next class.

### SR. SECONDARY SECTION (XI-XII)

For XI & XII classes the academic session is divided into 3 Periodic Tests & 2 Term examinations (Term 1 & Term 2 \*). For class XI the weightage to the Periodic Tests & Terms will be 20 (PTs) +30 (Term 1) +50 (Annual) for the final result. The DAV CAE will conduct Term End Examination (only for class XI) as per the guidelines provided by CBSE & DAVCAE. Each student of class XI will need to score at least 33% marks both in theory and practical exam/internal assessment separately in all subjects for promotion to Class XII.

\* Subject to change according to CBSE guidelines for the session 2026-27.

## THE SCHOOL'S WITHDRAWAL POLICY

- **LONG ABSENCE ( Without any Information)**
- **DISCIPLINARY GROUNDS :** The Principal may, in the interest of the school , order withdrawal of a student from school, if student's conduct, behaviour or influence is found detrimental to the general discipline/interest of the school.
- **NON -PAYMENT OF FEES :** All fees are payable in advance on a quarterly basis. The payment of the quarterly installment must be made by 15th of the first month of each quarter. If the amount due is not paid as per the fee schedule, name of the student will be struck off the school rolls without any notice.
- **ON-REQUEST WITHDRAWAL :** If the parent needs to withdraw the child at the completion of session in that case a proper application for the same needs to be submitted in the office latest by 31<sup>st</sup> March or before the commencement of next academic session.

## SCHOOL CONDUCT AND RESPONSIBILITY FRAMEWORK

### FOR PARENTS

- Regularly check the school diary and countersign all remarks made by teachers as an acknowledgment of communication from the school.
- Ensure that complete and updated contact details (address and phone numbers) are recorded in the student diary and inform the school immediately of any changes.
- Attend Parent–Teacher Meetings (PTMs), generally held on the second Saturday of each month, to stay informed about your ward's academic progress and behaviour.
- Ensure your ward maintains regular attendance and punctuality, as consistency is essential for academic success.
- Ensure your ward comes to school in the complete and proper school uniform, clean, well-ironed, and presentable.
- Cultivate in your ward good values, discipline, respect, honesty, and responsibility in daily conduct.
- Encourage your ward to follow personal hygiene, neatness, and proper grooming in accordance with school standards.
- Encourage your ward to be environmentally responsible, including the use of bicycles as a sustainable and eco-friendly mode of transport wherever feasible.
- Do not request half-day leave for your ward except in unavoidable emergencies.
- Do not permit your ward to bring mobile phones, smart watches, or electronic gadgets to school.

### FOR STUDENTS

- Bring the school diary daily, read all teacher remarks carefully, and ensure they are shown to parents for acknowledgment.
- Wear the complete prescribed school uniform during school hours and school functions; ensure it is clean, well-ironed, and worn with polished shoes.
- Follow good personal hygiene and present a tidy and disciplined appearance at all times.
- Carry all required books, notebooks, stationery, water bottle, and hand sanitizer daily.
- Show respect to teachers, peers, staff, and school property, and practice honesty, self-discipline, and tolerance.
- Support the school's commitment to sustainable development by using bicycles as an eco-friendly mode of transport wherever possible.
- Do not adopt inappropriate hairstyles such as undercuts, shaved designs, extreme styles, or any form of hair colouring, bleaching, straightening, perming, or highlighting.
